**Application for Post-Matric Scholarship for students belonging to the Minority
Communities for the year 2011-2012.**
Last date of receipt of application 16th August, 2011.

Applications are invited from the students belonging to the minority communities namely Muslims, Sikhs, Buddhists, Christians & Zoroastrians notified by the Central Government pursuing higher education, from Class XI to Ph.D., including technical/vocational courses of Industrial Training Institutes/Industrial Training Centres (affiliated with NCVT) in recognized School/Institute for Post-Matric Scholarship to be awarded by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India. Courses other than those listed under Merit-cum-Means scholarship scheme would be covered under the Post-Matric Scholarship Scheme.

Conditions for Scholarship

- (a) To students of Indian Citizens residing in Haryana State only.
- (b) Maintenance allowance will be credited into the student's bank account.
- (c) The continuance of award will be subject into securing 50% marks in the previous examination.
- (d) Students from BPL families will be given preference in the ascending order of family income.
- (e) A scholarship holder under this scheme will not avail of any other scholarship/stipend for pursuing the same course.
- (f) The annual income, from all sources, of the student's parents or guardian should not exceed Rs.2. lakh.
- (g) 30% of scholarship is reserved for girl students.
- (h) Scholarship will not be given to more than two students in a family.
- (i) The student/institution should mention the details of Contact No., Bank Account Number, Bank code Number and E-mail ID, so that maintenance allowance/course fee/tuition fee can be deposited in his/her account. If account No./Bank Code No. is not mentioned, the scholarship will not be sanctioned
